



## CLONEEN SQUASH COURT

### BOOKING RULES

*Court bookings can be made from Monday to Sunday, in person on the Timesheet on the Squash Club noticeboard or online on our website at [www.cloneenhall.com](http://www.cloneenhall.com)*

The Court Booking Rules are:

1. Courts are timed for 40 minutes and the "Official Court Clock" is in Squash court corridor.
2. All peak playing times are between, 7pm to 9pm and require both player names to be entered. For off-peak times a single player name is permitted.
3. The court may be booked in advance for league matches, provided members have no more than 2 peak time bookings during the 7 days in advance. This is to facilitate an opportunity for all members to book Peak Times.
4. Advance Booking for Coaching / Practice should be scheduled outside of Peak Times.
5. During a current week, members can take time slots not already taken on the night or up to 24 hours in advance. These slots can be used for matches, practice or coaching.
6. If a court booking is no longer required it is the players' responsibility to cancel it at least 2 hours in advance of the start time. Non-cancellation is very unfair to fellow club members (particularly in peak times) and offenders of this rule will be warned and noted. At the discretion of the Squash / Hall Committee persistent offenders may have their playing privileges withdrawn for up to 2 weeks.

7. Visitors (who must be affiliated with an insured Squash Club) are permitted to book games, off peak, or must become a member of Cloneen Squash Club if not already joined.
8. Where a club member wishes to play a visitor, they must specify the name "Visitor" on the Timesheet.
9. Consecutive bookings are only permitted off peak. Players may not use other member's names for bookings to circumvent any Booking rules.
10. Block booking of courts for GAA clubs, League semi-finals and finals, tournaments, etc. can only be made by the Squash Club Chairman and members will be notified if this is the case.
11. Members who abuse these rules may have their playing privileges withdrawn. Persistent offenders will be liable to suspension from the club.
12. Players should commence at their scheduled time, and not extend unreasonably into the next Time Slot.  
  
**Note:** League Games may extend into the next Time Slot and the following players must allow them to finish. The following players shall be allowed 45 minutes, from the time they get on Court.
13. Full names of players must be entered in the Time Slot. No initials please.

**And remember - It's only a game !!!!!**
